4. Participation
- a) The winner of a national championship can participate in the Champions Cup. Only players who have participated in the national championship for the winner can participate in the Champions Cup.
- b) The best team of a nation without a championship can participate in the Champions Cup. Only official team members are allowed to play. All players have to be an active playing and paying member of the team which the player represent. Team-license (team-passport) is necessary.
- c) The organizer decides on the participation. The organizer can refuse or allow teams.
5. Proof of authorization
- As winner of a national championship you must send a confirmation from your national UWR association You can send the tournament journal of the National Championship.
- A valid list of players of the national championship must be submitted or team license (team pass) is necessary.
- The validity of the tournament journal and the list of players must be confirmed by the national UWR association.
- In case of a violation, the team will be disqualified. The organizer decides on the participation. The organizer can refuse or allow teams. On a protest at the tournament this will be decided by the tournaments jury.
6. Unauthorized reinforcement
- It is not allowed to reinforce the team with players from other teams, clubs or other nations.
7. Entry fee
- € 600 per team. Men and women are separated teams.
€ 630 at team leader meeting, on Friday 2019-11-22
- Included are the costs for administration, cups and rent of the swimming pool as well as the costs for referees.
8. Other costs
- Travel (including from/to airport/train station/swimming pool) and lodging of the teams is not included in the entry fee. The teams will book and pay their lodging by themselves.
- Costs of Winner's ceremony (see at point 20)
All other costs are at the teams own expense.



14. Tournament jury The chief referee will summon the tournament jury and choose 2 team representatives and 1 referee so that no members of the jury will have the same nationality or have been involved in the game which the protest concerns.
- One referee (chief referee or referee appointed by chief referee).
 - Two team representatives (each team will name one person at the team leader meeting).

15. Referees The referees will be provided by the organizer.
16. Exclusion of athletes and teams at lack of sportsmanship. Athletes and team members who behave unsportsmanlike or morally doubtful at the tournament or at or around the ceremony will be exclude from the actual CC. This disqualification applies to the entire team. This disqualification applies to the following year for every team of this nation. This team will be excluded from the scoring. There is no claim for refund of any fees or costs.
17. Exclusion of liability Participation in the Champions Cup takes place at one's own risk. Berliner Unterwasser Rugby or VDST or any other local organization will not liable for any personal or material damages or costs.

27. EU data protection regulation

The abovementioned data serves to carry out the sport, the documentation of the competition itself, and its results. The publication of the data takes place on the website <http://www.uwr24.de/championscup/>

and during competition by notice and protocol. A disclosure of the data is only for sporting purposes. The event will be broadcast live on the internet. A sports event is a lawful publication for which personal consent is not necessary. Each participant of the Champions Cup is in agreement with the data collection and the particular use in sports. Persons who do not agree to the collection of sports relevant data cannot participate in the Champions Cup. Failure of the team leaders to inform their proper teams of the data collection and use in the tournament will lead to the right of the organizer to exclude this team from participation. We would like to expressly point out that the transmission of data via the Internet (e.g., by e-mail) can offer security vulnerabilities. It is therefore impossible to safeguard the data completely against access by third parties. We cannot assume any liability for damages arising as a result of such security vulnerabilities.
